

Mark 13:1-13

³And as he sat on the Mount of Olives opposite the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew asked him privately, ⁴"Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign when all these things are about to be accomplished?" ⁵And Jesus began to say to them, "See that no one leads you astray. ⁶Many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he!' and they will lead many astray. ⁷And when

you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed. This must take place, but the end is not yet. ⁸For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be earthquakes in various places; there will be famines. These are but the beginning of the birth pains.

But the one who endures to the end will be saved."

From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.





body, which is given for you. This do in remembrance of Me."




Proclamation of Christ


- P As often as we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.
