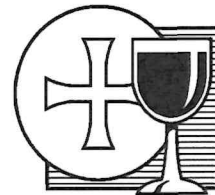
Are you a member or a guest? Pastoral Care - **All Visitor's and members**, please notice the red book on one end of your pew titled "Record of Fellowship".

We ask this out of Christian love and concern for you. (Please, indicate to Pastor if you require a Gluten Free Wafer.)
