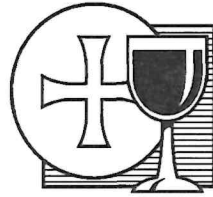


# Fourth Sunday after Trinity

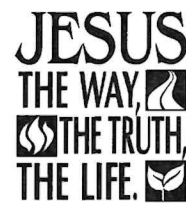
