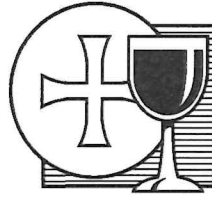


First Sunday after Trinity

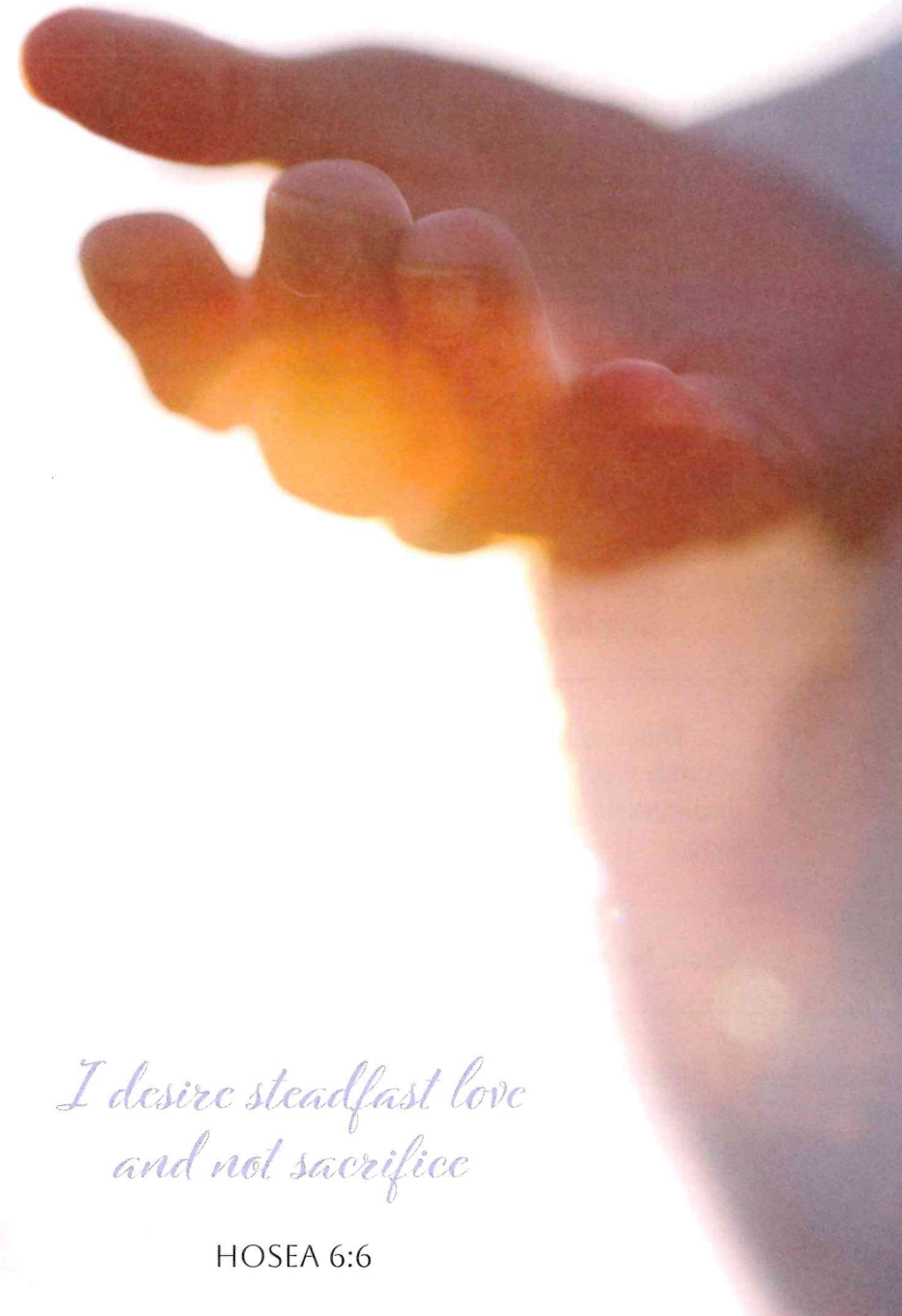
